



Rear Inflatable Seat Belt

Shoulder strap: The rear inflatable seat belt's webbing has a comfortable padded feel and smooth rolled edges unlike a standard seat belt

Lap strap: The lap belt webbing does not inflate, is the same as standard seat belt webbing, but has its own retracting system

Inflatable Belt Bag and Fill Tube: Each inflatable belt's tubular air bag inflates with cold compressed gas through a fill tube when a collision is detected

Buckle assembly and tongue: The buckle assembly and seat belt tongue are designed to allow gas to pass through it to the seat belt bag

Compressed gas inflator: A cylinder of cold compressed gas is housed below the seat and expels gas to the seat belt in case of a collision

Diffuser and manifold: Gas exits the cylinder by way of a diffuser and moves through the manifold to the buckle assembly
