Explorer Sport Trac is the unrestricted utility vehicle that delivers rugged styling, capable power and performance along with a versatile cargo area to take customers where they want to go. Blending the capable traits of Ford's iconic F-150 pickup and refinement of the Explorer SUV, Sport Trac is the best of both worlds and adds a growing number of standard features and exciting new technologies for the 2009 model year.

Trailer Sway Control, a new standard feature for 2009, works in conjunction with AdvanceTrac® with RSC® (Roll Stability Control) to determine from the yaw motion of the vehicle if the trailer is swaying and take measures – such as applying precise braking or reduced engine torque – to bring both vehicle and trailer under control.

AdvanceTrac with RSC delivers a level of performance that competitive stability control systems can't match. Unlike competitors' systems, Advance Trac with RSC utilizes a second gyroscopic roll rate sensor to determine the vehicle's body roll angle and roll rate.

A Convenience package was added to each series, XLT and Limited. The XLT Convenience package includes power adjustable and reverse sensing pedals, SecuriCode™, auto-dimming mirror, 6-way power driver seat and autolamps. The Limited Convenience package has dual-zone electronic temperature, 4-line message center, and power adjusting and reverse sensing pedals. A new Sun and SYNC value package with SYNC and a moonroof is also available as an XLT option.

Other new standard features available include next-generation navigation with SIRIUS® Travel Link™, satellite radio, heated leather seats, hard tonneau cover and heated side mirrors.
