The Lincoln MKX boasts a quiet Lincoln interior – thanks to Ford's innovative technologies that dramatically reduce noise, vibrations and harshness.

- An acoustic windshield made with a layer of sound-absorbent vinyl sandwiched between two sheets of glass significantly softens interior noise levels.
- Expandable foam pellets in the roof pillars reduce wind noise.
- Sound-deadening materials welded behind exterior trim panels and a constrained-layer barrier fused to the rear wheelhouses help quiet and smooth the ride.
- The spoiler is designed to reduce wind noise.

Lincoln MKX blends these unique technologies and materials to produce a personal, ultra-quiet oasis while you travel down the road.



Welcome to the Virtual Road

Ford is home to one of the world's most advanced driving simulators, the Virtual Test Track Experiment (VIRTEX) Lab that helps our researchers study driver distraction issues.



VIRTEX uses advanced computer graphics to create a virtual driving environment where participants drive a specially instrumented vehicle bolted inside the simulator. Here, an array of driving studies can be carefully controlled and reproduced, allowing us to gain more accurate and insightful results.

Since opening in 2001, VIRTEX studies have led to the development of programs, technologies and vehicle features designed to improve vehicle and occupant safety.



Six Speeds = Better Fuel Economy

The 2009 Lincoln MKX 6-speed transmission allows this sophisticated crossover to deliver good fuel economy.

- The advanced transmissions deliver 4 to 6 percent improvement in fuel efficiency on average compared with typical 4- and 5-speed gearboxes.
- Fuel efficiency is improved up to 7 percent in highway driving over typical 4-speed transmissions.
