The Navigator's commanding design, bolstered by its clean, tapered surfaces, brings a unique elegance and an unrivaled presence to the full-size luxury utility segment. And Navigator's frame and independent suspension deliver superior ride and handling while its acoustic windshield, thicker glass and tuned mirrors all contribute to Navigator's whisper-quiet interior.

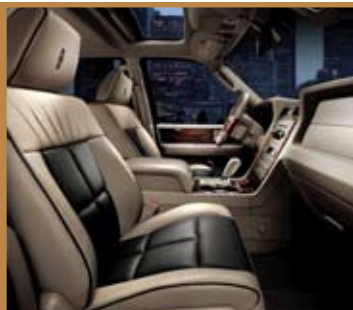
The new next-generation navigation system is available for the first time ever with SIRIUS Travel Link, which gives drivers and passengers access to up-to-the-minute information and entertainment. Working through the standard feature SIRIUS satellite radio network, Travel Link offers uninterrupted, coast-to-coast coverage of real-time traffic data, gas prices, sports and movie listings. A six-month introduction to SIRIUS is included at no cost.

The Navigator's interior has already received critical acclaim, winning the "Interior of the Year" award for premium-priced trucks as voted by the editorial staff of Ward's Auto World magazine in 2007. In 2009, the vehicle continues its emphasis on Lincoln luxury and class.

The interior features a flow-through center console that sweeps up into the rectangular "eyebrows" that frame the dash panel. The strong graphic presentation is echoed in the shape of the instrument bezels, a design inspired by popular fashion eyewear.

Lincoln Navigator offers the elegance of Dark Ebony or Anigre wood trim on the console and upper door panels. The wood trim is book matched so that the grains are precisely aligned. Even the coin tray cover is laser cut from the wood trim of the center console to perfectly match the wood grain.

Details like satin-nickel accent on the center stack, the binnacle inserts and the door trim, along with chrome accents on the cupholder rings and door releases speak to Navigator's fine craftsmanship. A touch of black on the center stack and instrument panel provides a further emphasis of refinement. At night, the interior is bathed in Lincoln's cool-white lighting, creating a soothing atmosphere.



LOOK FOR IN 2009

For 2009, Lincoln continues to simplify the packaging of Navigator and Navigator L, making standard many previously optional features.

- **Standard items now include:** Power liftgate, heated and cooled front seats; heated second row seats; PowerFold third-row seats; assist sensors; EasyFuel capless fuel filler; rain-sensing wipers; perimeter anti-theft alarm; integrated four-button key fob; Rear View Camera; flexible fuel-capable V8 engine; Lincoln SYNC and a 14-speaker THX II-Certified audio system with SIRIUS Satellite Radio.
- **A Monochrome Limited Edition Package for 2009** features unique badging along with body color exterior accents including lower grille, lower bodyside cladding and power folding heated memory mirrors with puddle lamps.
- **The Elite Package** includes the moonroof, next generation navigation system, power running boards, rear seat entertainment system and the Rear View Camera display.
