IT'S CAPABLE

- With 135 cubic feet of cargo volume, no other vehicle in the American market can deliver this combination of fuel economy and capacity.
- Split rear cargo doors open at a standard 180 degrees, or an optionally available 225 degrees. When open, these doors provide access to 52.1 inches of available load height.
- Lift-over height is less than two feet unloaded.
- Cargo payload of 1,600 pounds.
- Power-assisted rack and pinion steering allows for a 39-foot curb-to-curb turning circle, ensuring easy maneuverability in tight quarters.



IT'S DURABLE

- With a global track record of durability, Transit Connect is a purpose-built commercial vehicle, built on a dedicated commercial vehicle platform in an exclusively commercial vehicle production facility.
- Powered by a proven Duratec 2.0-liter DOHC four-cylinder engine.
- Four-speed automatic transaxle with overdrive for additional fuel economy and a final drive ratio of 4.20:1 designed to provide pulling power for the long haul.
- Developed to be durable from the onset, Transit Connect has a boron steel front crossmember, a high-strength steel reinforced body shell, twin-side cross members and side impact protection.

IT'S ADAPTABLE

- Ford Work Solutions allows customers to run a business from inside the vehicle – right from the job site with tools like Took Link, by DeWALT™ and Crew Chief™.
- Tool Link uses Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) tags that adhere to the tools or objects themselves and scans the cargo for tools and inventory items prior to leaving the jobsite.
- Crew Chief™ allows fleet managers to track vehicles and staff by having online access to vehicle location, speed, idle time, fuel usage and more than 30 diagnostic measures.
- Bulkheads, racks, bins and other upfits can be mixed, matched and configured to suit many specific commercial applications and needs.
- Transit Connect is available in van XL, van XLT and wagon configurations.
