EPAS



Electric power-assisted steering (EPAS) reduces the load on the engine since a belt-driven power steering pump is no longer required. Built-in pull-drift compensation detects road conditions – such as a crowned road surface or crosswinds – and adjusts the steering system to help the driver compensate for pulling and drifting.



ECO-FRIENDLY SEATS



Escape Hybrid continues its theme of sustainability with available eco-friendly seats. The seats are made from 100 percent post-industrial recycled materials. Eco-friendly seats created with soy-based foam that substitutes for petroleum-based products also are available on the Escape.
