EPAS



The 2012 Fusion is equipped with advanced electric power-assisted steering (EPAS) providing responsive road feel and enhanced on-center balance while offering the additional benefit of increased fuel economy. EPAS also reduces the load on the engine since a belt-driven power steering pump is no longer required. Fusion's front anti-roll bar and rear suspension link geometry help ensure confident steering, handling and ride. The suspension elements have been tuned to take full advantage of EPAS.
