Ford Europe Goes All-In on EVs on Road to Sustainable Profitability; Cologne Site Begins \$1 Billion Transformation

Ford committed that by mid-2026, 100 percent of Ford's passenger vehicle range in Europe will be zero-emissions capable, all-electric or plug-in hybrid, and will be completely all electric by 2030. Similarly, Ford's entire commercial vehicle range will be zero-emissions capable, all-electric or plug-in hybrid, by 2024, with two-thirds of Ford's commercial vehicle sales expected to be all-electric or plug-in hybrid by 2030.

Ranger Tremor Production Begins


Production began this week on the first Ranger Tremors at Michigan Assembly Plant. Customers can expect to see trucks hitting dealer lots in the coming weeks.
