



Who should be vaccinated?

Helping you make an informed choice

Individuals age 18 or older who do not have a medical condition preventing them from receiving the vaccine. Individuals with certain medical conditions associated with an increased risk of serious illness if they become infected with the Covid-19 virus have been given priority in some states.

How Do I Know If I Am “High Risk”?

- People who are over the age of 65 or have one or more health conditions including, but not limited to: lung disease, heart disease, kidney disease, cancer and diabetes, are at higher risk of developing serious illness if they become infected with the Covid-19 virus.

I Am Healthy and Not In A High Risk Group. Why Should I Get Vaccinated?

- Getting vaccinated will protect you as well as those around you. Some people may not be able to receive the vaccine, therefore, you can protect them as well.

Will I Need The COVID-19 Vaccine To Go To Sporting Events Or To Travel?

- It is unknown at this time.

I Already Had COVID-19 And Have The Antibodies. Do I Need To Get Vaccinated?

- Yes, Getting COVID-19 may provide some natural protection or immunity from getting COVID-19 repeatedly, however, it is not clear how long this protection lasts. Because reinfection is possible, the CDC recommends that those who have already had COVID-19 should get a COVID-19 vaccine. Please consult your primary care physician for additional information.
