

COVID-19 Protocol Update



As we continue to monitor federal, state, and local data, along with recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Ford Motor Company has updated COVID-19 protocols for U.S. employees.

Effective Aug. 2, you are no longer required to complete the online daily COVID-19 self-certification survey prior to entering a U.S. Ford facility.

Posters will be placed at building entrances, including [collaboration centers](#), as a reminder to monitor yourself for symptoms daily and to provide information on what to do if you are currently diagnosed with COVID-19 or have been in close contact with someone who has been diagnosed.

In addition, onsite and offsite, social events are now permitted.

- Maintaining a social/physical distance of 6 feet is still recommended where possible
- Ford will continue to provide masks for all employees who choose to wear a mask
- If your Ford on-site work location is located in a county that has an orange/high-risk status, as determined by the CDC, you are strongly encouraged to wear a face mask indoors when with others.
- As the number of cases across the country continue to fluctuate, Ford encourages you to monitor the situation in your community and take appropriate actions to remain healthy and safe.
