

COVID-19 Vaccination Information

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has updated its guidance on vaccinations to include an updated booster dose. This is the newly approved bivalent formulation that provides protection against Omicron variants BA4 and BA5, through products manufactured by Moderna and Pfizer.

All adults who have previously been vaccinated with the Moderna, Pfizer, Novavax or Johnson and Johnson vaccine series are eligible for this booster dose 2 months after their most recent dose of the vaccine; this includes other booster doses previously received.

With the BA5 strain now being the predominant strain of the virus in the US, everyone should consider getting the bivalent booster dose when eligible.
