## 47 Is it a van? Is it a boat? No, its a Hovervan!

The Transit can cope with all manner of road conditions, but what happens when you're faced with floods, or an unavoidable river crossing? The BBC Top Gear team took a standard Transit van and added two extra engines with a combined output of 600hp, and a skirt. Able to quickly transform from a road vehicle to a hovercraft, it was able skim over water, but, as with many Top Gear escapades, not without the occasional incident.

#### 43 The SuperVan 4.2 tackles the Pikes Peak

Inspired by the Ford E-Transit Custom, the SuperVan 4.2, with its 1,400 horsepower produced by three electric motors took to the Pikes Peak International Hillclimb in Colorado in 2023.



# 46 The most powerful production Transit yet – and it's electric

The MS-RT Ford E-Transit Custom has an electric motor with a power output equivalent to 285PS (281HP). That's over six and a half times more power than that 43.6PS (43hp) diesel engine fitted to the first Ford Transit in 1965.
